

Vs State of Maharastra (Writ Petition 995 of 201) where the state relied on the circular issued by Ministyry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change ofGovernment of India (Communication dated 29 August 2018) for promoting procurement of recycled paper. In this case where the condition for "use of recycled paper was challenged by the petitioners' Hon'ble Bombay high Court dismissed this writ for not holding any merit as the same has already been examined by the Union Government and UGC.	I/We must state that in the published tender there are many sections and clauses which provides for the use of "70 gSm Text Paper Maplitho Virgin", however, it is pertinent to note that the specification for the quality of paper as prescribed in the tender bid document on Page No. 39- Point No.6 - "Printing Paper" under specification for Printing, binding, Packing and supply of textbook with cover paper, the same requisite specification can be procured by Non-Virgin Recycled Paper.
